WILLIAM D. RAZZ WAFF MAJOR GENERAL, US ARMY RETIRED

William D. Razz Waff is a Personnel Policy and Systems Expert for Military Experts, LLC, a consulting firm that advises businesses and attorneys nationwide on military issues.

General Waff retired from the Army in 2015 with over 39 years of active and reserve service. His final assignment was as the Deputy Chief of Personnel (G1) for the Department of the Army. Before that, he was the Commanding General, 99th Regional Support Command.

As the Deputy G1, General Waff was responsible for a wide range of personnel functions, including the implementation of the Army Total Force Policy, coordinating the care of wounded warriors with the Department of Veterans Affairs, and the Integrated Pay and Personnel System - Army. Additionally, he served as the Chairman of the Army Reserve Forces Policy Committee. During his time in uniform, General Waff served as President or as a member of numerous Army promotion and command selection boards.

General Waff began his military career attending the Virginia Military Institute and later the University of Mississippi, graduating magna cum laude in 1976 with a Bachelor of Music degree. He completed the Adjutant General's Corps Officer Basic and Advanced Courses, the Army Medical Officer Advanced Course and the Senior Officer Transportation Advanced Course. He also completed the Command and General Staff College (Resident-RC), the Army War College's Reserve Component National Security Issues Seminar, the Army War College's Defense Strategy Course and the Army War College's Senior Service College Course (Distance Education), being awarded the Master of Strategic Studies degree in 2001. He is also a graduate of the Department of Defense Modeling and Simulations Officer Course.

General Waff has also had a distinguished civilian career as a priest and chaplain, primarily in healthcare settings. He received a Master of Divinity degree from Seabury-Western Theological Seminary in Evanston, Illinois in 1983, and a doctorate in medical ethics through a joint venture of the Graduate Theological Foundation and Georgetown University in 1997.
