## JIMMIE BROWNING, M.D. COLONEL (RETIRED), U.S. ARMY RESERVE

Dr. Jimmie Browning is a military Disability Evaluation System expert for Military Experts, LLC, a consulting firm that advises businesses and attorneys nationwide on military issues.

Dr. Browning retired from the Army Reserve in 2009 after 37 years of military service, having enlisted as a Private in the Marine Corps in 1968, and retiring as a Colonel in the Army's Medical Corps. Dr. Browning served both on active duty and in the reserves throughout his long career. He was mobilized for overseas service in OPERATION DESERT SHIELD/STORM and OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. His military career culminated in eight years as the Command Surgeon for the 88th Regional Readiness Command. In this role, he was responsible for the medical readiness and deployability of 25,000 soldiers. Over the course of his career, Dr. Browning routinely took part in the Army's decisions to retain or medically separate ill and injured solders both as a command surgeon and as a member of dozens of disability evaluation boards.

Dr. Browning graduated from Emporia Kansas State University in 1975, and Kansas University School of Medicine in 1978. He completed his residency at Wesley Medical Center in Wichita Kansas. Dr. Browning was board certified in family medicine (1981-2020), actively practicing and teaching until his civilian retirement in 2017. Dr. Browning has a wide breadth of practice experience, having spent the 17 years of his medical career in a rural area of Kansas, then moving to a large city in Minnesota where he treated patients and taught Residents for another 18 years.
